

True's Yard

The North End Trust was formed in 1987 to save this, the last remaining fishermen's yard in the country. It is typical of those that once surrounded the beautiful chapel of St Nicholas and is in the very heart of this famous old fishing community.

The King's Lynn Borough Council purchased the derelict property and leased it back to the Trust. The small committee of Northenders, or those of North End fishing families, then had to raise the £150,000 needed to complete restoration.

The Trust is entirely self-supporting and relies on assistance from the public for the day to day running.

The exhibits in the museum and cottages have all been donated to the Trust and, to the many thousands of people and schoolchildren who visit the complex, serve as an important reminder of this once famous fishing community.
